Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E conducted a public meeting on Tuesday, January 8, 2018 at Northwest One Neighborhood Library, 155 L Street, NW, to consider the applicant's request for support for a new Class "C" Tavern license.

At the Commission's meeting, duly noticed, with a quorum present (four out of seven Commissioners required to be in attendance to achieve a quorum), ANC 6E voted unanimously (5 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstention) to protest the application based on the following:

- The effect of the establishment on real property values;
- The effect of the establishment on peace, order, and quiet, including the noise and litter provisions set forth in §§ 25-725 and 25-726; and
- The effect of the establishment upon residential parking needs and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

The Commission similarly voted to elect Commissioner Michael Brown of 6E02, who represents the Single Member District where the establishment is located, to represent the Commission before the Board for this matter.
