

**Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E
Special Public Meeting

A Special Public Meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E convened at the Kennedy Recreation Center, 1401 7th Street, NW, Washington, DC, on Tuesday, July 23, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. and the presence of a quorum was noted. Chair Alex Marriott presided.

II. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

MOTION: Commissioner Marriott moved and Commissioner Nigro seconded that the agenda be approved. The Motion **passed** unanimously, 6 yeas (Commissioners Marriott, Wiggins, Padro, Nigro, Brown, and Rogers) – 0 nays – 0 abstentions.

III. 649 NEW YORK AVENUE, NW (LEON): REQUEST FOR SUPPORT FOR A STIPULATED ALCOHOL LICENSE [6E04]

MOTION: Commissioner Nigro moved and Commissioner Padro seconded that ANC 6E **support** the request for support for a Stipulated Alcohol License of Leon, 649 New York Avenue, NW, and that said support be communicated in writing to the ABC Board and ABRA. The Motion **passed** unanimously, 6 yeas (Commissioners Marriott, Wiggins, Padro, Nigro, Brown, and Rogers) – 0 nays – 0 abstentions.

IV. 1503 9TH STREET, NW: REQUEST FOR SUPPORT FOR STIPULATED AND PERMANENT ABC CT (TAVERN) LICENSES (QUEEN OF SHEBA 2, INC. T/A QUEEN'S RESTAURANT AND LOUNGE) [6E01]

Commissioner Padro reported that Queen of Sheba 2, d/b/a Queen's Restaurant and Lounge, 1503 9th Street, NW, has changed their ABRA application from a CR (Restaurant) to a CT (Tavern) license. ANC 6E approved a CR license at its meeting on July 2, 2019. ANC 6E needs to re-vote on the application reflecting the change in class.

MOTION: Commissioner Padro moved and Commissioner Rogers seconded that ANC 6E **support** the request for support of Queen of Sheba 2, Inc., d/b/a Queen's Restaurant and Lounge, 1503 9th Street, NW, for Stipulated and Permanent ABC CT (Tavern) Licenses, with an Entertainment Endorsement, and that said support be communicated in writing to the ABC Board and ABRA. The Motion **passed** unanimously, 6 yeas (Commissioners Marriott, Wiggins, Padro, Nigro, Brown, and Rogers) – 0 nays – 0 abstentions.

V. APPROVAL OF QUARTERLY REPORTS FOR FY 18 (QTR 3), FY 18 (QTR 4) AND FY 19 (QTR 1, QTR 2, QTR 3)

MOTION: Commissioner Marriott moved and Commissioner Brown seconded that ANC 6E approve the quarterly reports for FY 18 (Qtr 3), FY 18 (Qtr 4), and FY 19 (Qtr 1, Qtr 2, Qtr 3) and that said reports be sent to the Office of Neighborhood Advisory Commissions. The Motion **passed**, 5 yeas (Commissioners Marriott, Wiggins, Nigro, Brown, and Rogers) – 1 nay (Commissioner Padro) – 0 abstentions.

VI. 919 5TH STREET, (COMMUNAL RESTAURANT, LLC d/b/a SILO): CONSIDER RENEWAL OF CLASS C ALCOHOL LICENSE [6E05]

MOTION: Commissioner Marriott moved and Commissioner Padro seconded that ANC 6E approve the retainer agreement with Jim Loots to represent ANC 6E in the matter of the Communal Restaurant, LLC, d/b/a Silo, alcohol license renewal in the amount of \$7,500. The Motion **passed** unanimously, 6 yeas (Commissioners Marriott, Wiggins, Padro, Nigro, Brown, and Rogers) – 0 nays – 0 abstentions.

VII. APPROVAL OF EXPENSES

MOTION: Commissioner Brown moved and Commissioner Padro seconded that the invoice submitted by Karen Jehle in the amount of \$250.00 for recording services for the **ANC 6E July 23, 2019 Special Public Meeting** and maintenance of the website be approved. The Motion **passed** unanimously, 6 yeas (Commissioners Marriott, Padro, Wiggins, Brown, Nigro, and Rogers) – 0 nays – 0 abstentions.

VIII. ADJOURNMENT

MOTION: There being no further business to come before the Commission, Commissioner Padro moved and Commissioner Wiggins seconded that the meeting be adjourned. The Motion ***passed*** unanimously, 6 yeas (Commissioners Marriott, Brown, Padro, Wiggins, Nigro, and Rogers) – 0 nays – 0 abstentions. The meeting adjourned at 7:01 p.m.
