

## **DC Council Timeline**

December 2021:	Ward boundaries approved by Council
January 2022:	Taskforces started meeting

- April 1, 2022: Taskforce reports due to Council
- April 2022: Council hearings on ANC/SMD boundaries
- **Spring 2022**: Council Redistricting subcommittee vote
- June 2022: Full Council vote



### **Key Terms**

Ward 2 has the following ANCs:

- 2A (Foggy Bottom / West End)
- 2B (Dupont Circle)
- 2C (Downtown DC / Chinatown / Penn Quarter)
- 2D (Sheridan Circle / Kalorama)
- 2E (Georgetown / Burleith / Hillandale)
- 2F (Logan Circle)
- 2G (Shaw, several SMDs from ANC 6E)
- Single Member Districts = SMDs
- Advisory Neighborhood Commissions = ANCs
- Commissioner = Leader elected by SMD neighbors
- Example: ANC 2F has 8 SMDs, each with 1 Commissioner



## **Guiding Principles**

Imperatives for the work of Redistricting Taskforces Process...

- Meetings open to public
- Use 2020 Census total population data
- Do not dilute "the voting strength of minority citizens"

Strive for...

- Keeping Census Blocks together and ANCs within 1 ward
- Creating SMDs of 1,900 to 2,100 residents
- Meeting the expectations described in DC Code ~ many details outlined here: https://www.elissasilverman.com/redistricting


#### Some Sample Rationales shared by creators of the 3 draft maps:


- Contiguous / Compact and Target 3 to 8 SMDs per ANC
- Compact / distinct communities (avoid crossing major commercial corridors) of 1900 to 2100 residents
- ANC/SMDs that allow Shaw residents to determine the neighborhood's commercial activities, development, District services, and recreational opportunities.
- Balanced populations by quantity (1900 2100 people per SMD)
- Reflecting demographics (SMDs that contain both affordable and market rate housing)
- Both sides of 9th Street NW commercial corridor in the same ANC for the first time
- Public safety concerns addressed within Third Police District (except for 1 block)
- Balance the workload of Commissioners and duration of ANC meetings

#### Some Sample Rationales shared by creators of the 3 draft maps:

- Re-uniting Shaw neighborhoods (including Blagden Alley Naylor Court Historic District, Mount Vernon Square Historic District, and Truxton Circle)
- Unite neighborhood north of Rhode Island Avenue NW in its own SMD
- Joining McCullough Terrace apartments, DC Convention Center, Mount Vernon Square in same ANC
- 1 SMD with DC Convention Center (Events DC), adjacent hotel, Mount Vernon Square (Carnegie Library)
- Both sides of 9th Street NW commercial corridor in the same ANC for the first time
- Proposing 1 cross-ward SMD that would include part of Ward 5 (192 residents of SMD 6E04 who have been recently redistricted from ANC 6E to Ward 5)







- Map 2: 9 SMDs (submitted by Taskforce Member)


### How might changes made to adjacent ANC borders impact ANC 2F?

- ANC 2B and 2F both have SMDs with populations greater than 2100 residents
- For example, 2F03 and 2B05 each have 2,709 residents
- 2B07 has 2484 residents
- 2B09 has 2596 residents



#### NOTES:

This map (1) adds an additional SMD to ANC2B, 2B10, to balance the population; and (2) adjusts the abutting boundaries of ANC2B & ANC2D to increase the current population of ANC2D. The gray area marked "XX" is excluded from ANC2B and unassigned.

Within these ANC boundary perimeters, the SMD boundaries can be adjusted to consider neighborhood nuances & concerns.





The next draft map is a result of meetings with Taskforce members representing:

- ANC 2C (Downtown/ Chinatown/ Penn Quarter)
- ANC 2D (Sheridan Circle/ Kalorama)
- ANC 2E (Georgetown/ Burleith/ Hillandale)

#### How might changes made to adjacent ANC borders impact ANC 2F?

- ANC 2C lost 1 of 3 SMDs (2C02)
- An area east of Chinatown has been redistricted to Ward 6
- 2C01 now has 2690 residents and 2C03 has 1960 residents
- Desire to grow beyond 2 SMDs / Commissioners
- Expand west and north toward Farragut Square and Scott Circle
- Dense residential buildings amid commercial areas
- Potential to add 1 or 2 SMDs to ANC 2C
- Early discussion on Taskforce about collaborating with Shaw ANC that is also growing in population



2013 ANC boundaries with new proposed ANC/SMD boundaries for 2C, 2D, and 2E.

Note: 2E includes proposed split census blocks between E01/02, 2E01/03, 2E04/05, and 2E03/08 Note: YY represents the previously split census block holding Francis Stevens and Francis Field.
