Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E conducted a virtual public meeting on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, to consider supporting the Mount Vernon Triangle CID's application for funding from the DC Commission on the Arts and Humanities FY 2023 Public Art Building Communities (PABC) program for a public sculpture located in our area.

During our ANC meeting Kenyattah Robinson, the Mount Vernon Triangle CID Executive Director and artist My Ly described a proposed heart-shaped sculpture under consideration for 400 K St NW. The proposed work of public art -- an innovative and unique heart-shaped sculpture that would rotate and be illuminated from within -- would enhance the Mt. Vernon Triangle neighborhood and provide additional visual interest along the K Street corridor.

At the Commission's meeting, duly noticed, with a quorum present (four out of seven Commissioners required to be in attendance to achieve a quorum), ANC 6E voted to support (5 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstention) the Mount Vernon Triangle CID application for Public Art Building Communities (PABC) FY23 grant program.
