RE: Resolution requesting that DDOT convert one side of all of the in Single Member District 6E04 to Resident-Only Parking

Dear Director Lott:

On November 1, 2022, at the duly noticed and regularly scheduled meeting of the Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E (“ANC 6E” or “Commission”) and with a quorum of 6 out of 6 Commissioners and the public present, ANC 6E approved the following resolution by a vote of 5 for, 0 against, and 0 abstentions:

WHEREAS, the pandemic has subsided greatly and the Walter E. Washington Convention Center and the Capital One Arena are reopen and hosting large conventions and events that draw thousands of people to our neighborhood on a daily basis. The Convention Center has 1.1 million visitors yearly;

WHEREAS, currently both sides of the streets allow for two hour visitor parking hindering the residents finding parking especially at night;

WHEREAS, there are new developments occurring in our area especially the MidCity project at 5th St. and M St. which will have 363 units and the 1001 6th St. project which will have 550 units. Both projects will bring additional cars to the area;

THEREFORE, ANC 6E resolves that DDOT convert one side of the streets in Single Member District 6E04 (soon to be 2G03/5E01 due to redistricting) to Residential Only Parking.

Furthermore ANC 6E resolves that the signs be similar to the signs near National Stadium. Please see the pictures below.

- 1200 block of New Jersey Ave. NW
- 200, 400 block of New York Ave. NW

- 400 block of O St. NW
- 400 block of Ridge St. NW
- 1200 block of 4th St. NW
- 1100, 1200, 1300 block of 5th St. NW

- 1100 block of 6th of 6th St. NW
