location of FEMS Engine Company 3.

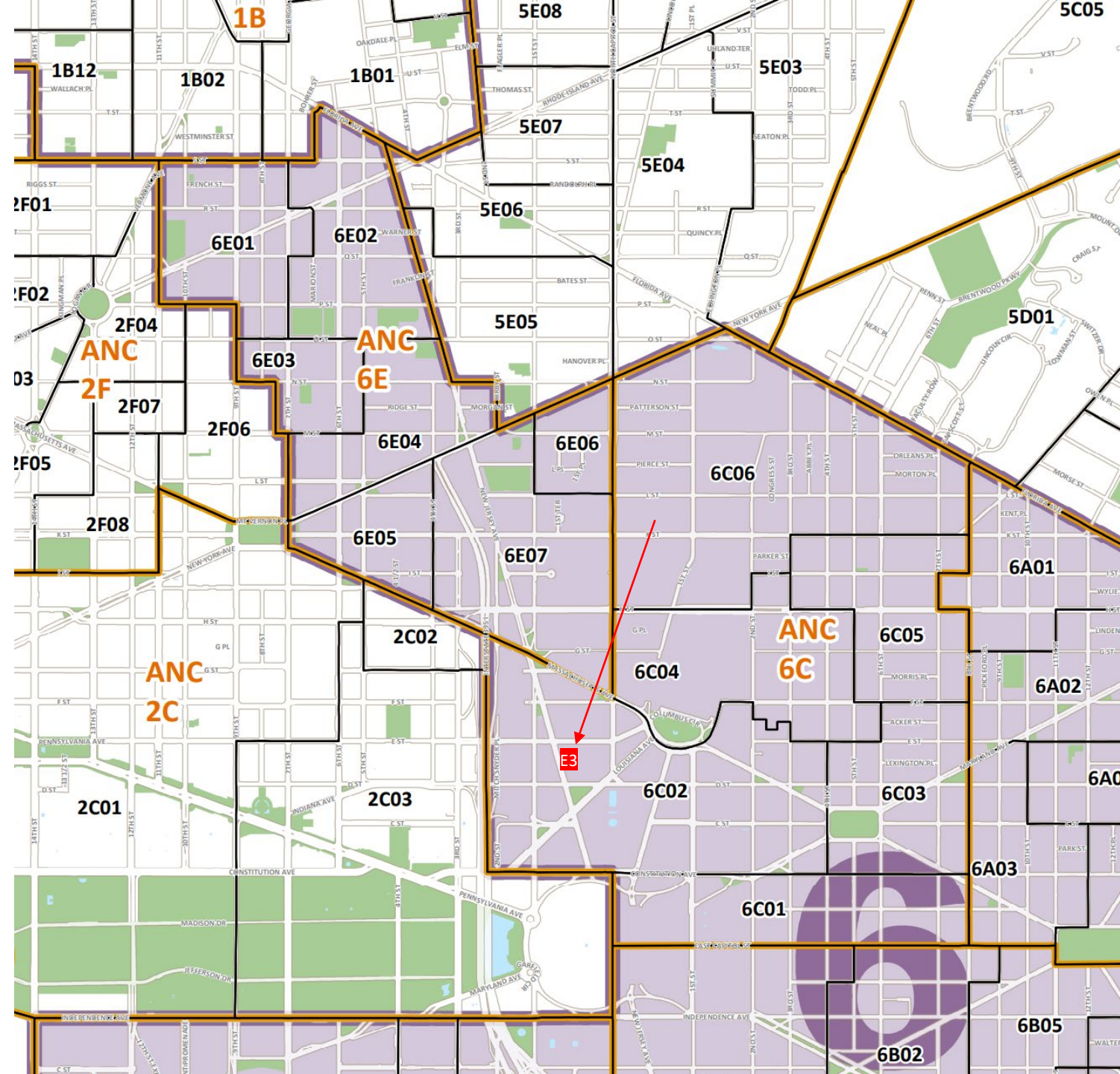

The red arrow marks the approximate location of FEMS Engine Company 3, in context with the revised ANC and SMD boundaries.

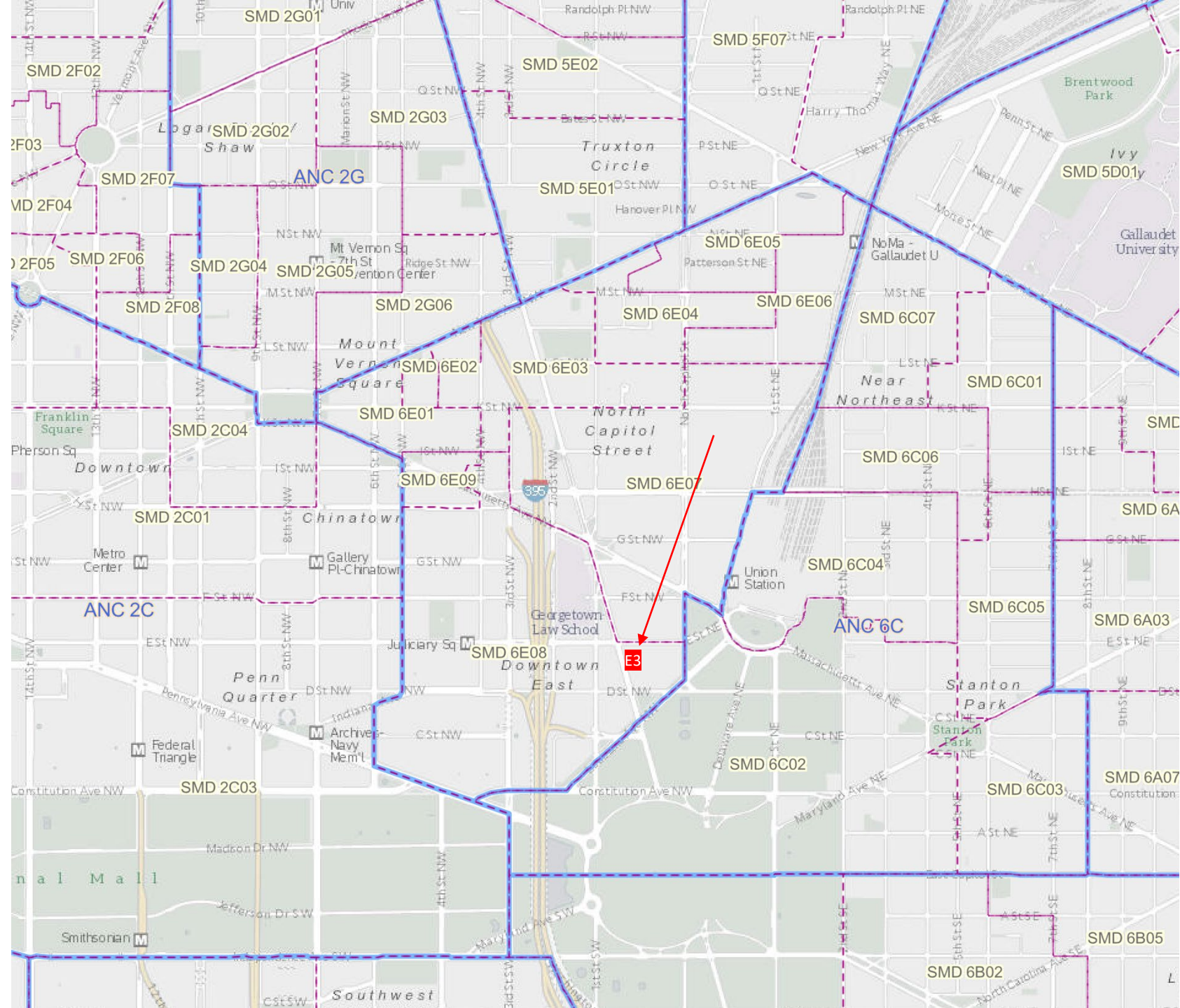

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code §10-801, the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development will conduct a public surplus hearing regarding the project identified as Engine 3 and encompassing the land parcels located at 427 New Jersey Ave, NW and 439 New Jersey Ave, NW (Square 630, Lots 831 and 833) (together, the “Property”) to obtain community input on the potential public uses of the Property to inform the Mayor’s determination whether the real property is no longer required for public purposes. A summary of received comments and suggestions will be submitted to the Council of the District of Columbia pursuant to D.C. Official Code §10-801(a-1)(2)(c).

The Property is comprised of two lots totaling approximately 13,816 square feet (0.317 acre). Current uses include: the D.C. Fire and EMS Department’s Engine Company 3 and the DC Fire & EMS Museum; a standalone one-story facility currently utilized by DOEE; and surface parking. The Property is located in Ward 6 and ANC6C SMD02, and is bounded by E Street, NW to the north; New Jersey Ave, NW to the west; and alleys to the south and east.

The public hearing will be held in-person at the date, time, and location listed below. In consideration of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the District of Columbia, the public hearing will include an online option for those members of the public who wish to attend virtually.

- Engine 3 is located in Ward 6, just north of the US Capitol, between Union Station and 395. The site is surrounded by Georgetown Law School, five hotels, and proximity to the National Mall.
- D-3 zoning has significant density potential, creating opportunities for residential, retail & office uses.
- This project will preserve one of D.C.'s most historic firehouses and deliver a new, modern fire station for Engine Company 3. DGS is relocating DOEE's facility to another site.
- The RFP will be released at the end of April.
