

Dear Chairperson Hood and Members of the Zoning Commission:

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting held on June 6, 2023, with a quorum of 7 of 9 commissioners being present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC”) 6E voted to support Georgetown University’s application for Mandatory Design Review in a Downtown Zone for Lot 865 and a portion of Lot 864 in Square 569. The ANC is excited about the design review application and appreciates the University’s engagement with the ANC. The building is consistent with the use of other buildings in the immediate area and makes use of an attractive design that opens the campus to the surrounding community. The resolution was approved by a vote of 7-0-0.
