## RE: Resolution in Support of the Proposed Enclosed Sidewalk Cafe at 22 M Street NE

Dear Chair Garrett,

On May 28, 2024, at a duly noticed and regularly scheduled meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E ("ANC 6E" or "Commission") conducted virtually via videoconference and with a quorum of 5 out of 9 Commissioners and the public present, ANC 6E approved the following resolution by a vote of 5 for, zero against, and zero abstentions:

WHEREAS, the Duties and Responsibilities of the Advisory Neighborhood Commission Act of 1975 grants ANC 6E the responsibility to advise the Council of the District of Columbia, the Mayor, and each executive agency and all independent agencies, boards, and commissions of the government of the District of Columbia with respect to all matters of District government policy, including decisions regarding planning, streets, recreation, social services programs, education, health, safety, and sanitation which affect the ANC 6E area;

WHEREAS, 22 M Street NE is located within the jurisdictional boundaries of ANC 6E in Single Member Districts 6E05;

WHEREAS, Ethan Bingeman of //38770, on the behalf of King Street Oyster Bar, presented on the proposed enclosed sidewalk cafe at 22 M Street NE to ANC 6E on May 28, 2024, and the attending commissioners expressed no concerns regarding the proposal;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC 6E supports the application for an enclosed sidewalk cafe at 22 M Street NE (tracking number: 11078904) submitted by David Tacz on the behalf of King Street Oyster Bar.
