10. GEORGETOWN UNIVERSITY NEW LAW BUILDING – MODIFICATION OF SIGNIFICANCE TO DESIGN REVIEW (ZC 23-10) – RE: BICYCLE PARKING AND SIGNAGE

MOTION: The Commission AGREED (6 yeas – 0 nays – 0 abstentions) to SUPPORT – (1) the addition of the signage identifying the top of the law building facing 2nd Street; and (2) that Georgetown University have relief from the short-term bicycle parking requirements which would require 68 spaces from that short distance of that new building and that the Commission endorse the University's proposed plan by treating this on a more holistic basis across the Law Center and the rest of the campus with 154 spaces – 64 on the Eleanor Holmes Norton Green and 90 spaces on the Dean Green as shown on the inverted U racks.
