Dear Mr. Gurara:

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting held on November 19, 2024, with a quorum of 6 of 9 commissioners present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC") 6E voted to support the NOI-24-289-TESD, which would implement a signal adjustment to add a new protected left turn phase and create of a new turning lane at 6th and K Streets, NW, and remove parking spaces on 6th St between Massachusetts Ave., NW, and New York Ave., NW, to accommodate the lane changes.

ANC 6E supports the proposed improvements, as ANC 6E believes that the improvements will significantly increase driver and pedestrian safety at what is currently a dangerous intersection. ANC 6E expresses its appreciation to DDOT for considering the ANC's previous feedback on NOI 24-245-TESD and implementing these additional changes as a result.
