Dear Mr. Labrador,

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting held on April 30, 2025, with a quorum of 4 of 8 commissioners being present and one seat vacant, Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC") 6E voted to support modifications to alley closures for the Community for Creative Nonviolence (CCNV), 425 2<sup>nd</sup> St NW, (file S.O. 25-01939), with four commissioners in favor, none opposed, and none abstaining, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Duties and Responsibilities of the Advisory Neighborhood Commission Act of 1975 grants ANC 6E the responsibility to advise the Council of the District of Columbia, the Mayor, and each executive agency and all independent agencies, boards, and commissions of the government of the District of Columbia with respect to all matters of District government policy, including decisions regarding planning, streets, recreation, social services programs, education, health, safety, and sanitation which affect the ANC 6E area;

WHEREAS, the Community for Creative Non-Violence (CCNV), a shelter at 425 2<sup>nd</sup> St NW, is located within the jurisdictional boundaries of ANC 6E;

WHEREAS, Rico Harris, Chapman Todd, and Christopher Cohen, representing CCNV, came before the ANC on April 30, 2025, to request the ANC's support for CCNV's application to close parts of the public alleys adjacent to the CCNV (file S.O. 25-01939);

WHEREAS, the proposed alley closures would be in compliance with relevant DC regulations, facilitate the construction of a modern shelter adjacent to CCNV, and attending commissioners expressed support for the concept;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC 6E supports the proposal to close parts of the public alleys adjacent to CCNV.
