3. REMARKS BY COUNCILMEMBER CHARLES ALLEN

Councilmember Allen expressed concerns about the presence of Federal law enforcement in Washington, describing it as inappropriate, unnecessary, and a challenge to the Home Rule Act. He advised residents to record on their phones any encounters they witness and requested that ANCs spread the word to their constituents. Additionally, he encouraged residents to contact advocacy groups like the ACLU and Free DC for support.

MOTION: The Commission ADOPTED (5 yeas – 0 nays – 0 abstentions) a resolution condemning Federal overreach in District of Columbia policing and demanding the immediate return of local funds and conveying those asks to Congress and the White House through the DC Home Rule Caucus. (Motion by Commissioner Prince, Second by Commissioner Hans).
