Dear Mr. Marcou,

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting held on December 18, 2025, with quorum present (5 commissioners present, 3 commissioners absent, and 1 vacant single-member district), ANC 6E voted (5 Ayes-0 Abstains-0 Nays) as follows:

WHEREAS, the Duties and Responsibilities of the Advisory Neighborhood Commission Act of 1975 grants ANC 6E the responsibility to advise the Council of the District of Columbia, the Mayor, and each executive agency and all independent agencies, boards, and commissions of the government of the District of Columbia with respect to all matters of District government policy, including decisions regarding planning, streets, recreation, social services programs, education, health, safety, and sanitation which affect the ANC 6E area;

WHEREAS, representatives from Events DC presented on the Krewe of Pyros Second Line Parade, which will be held in January 2026, before ANC 6E;

WHEREAS, ANC 6E has no concerns regarding the road closures that will be occurring within the Commission's geographic boundaries to hold the event, titled Krewe of Pyros Second Line Parade;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that ANC 6E supports the Krewe of Pyros Second Line Parade event and conveys to DDOT that the Commission has no concerns regarding any road closures caused by the event.
