Re: ANC6E Support for DDOT NOI 22-149-TOA: Bus Stop Relocation and Curbside Redesignations of 5th, 6th, and K Streets NW

Mr. Lipscomb:

On May 3rd, 2022, at a duly noticed and regularly scheduled meeting of ANC6E conducted via videoconference with a quorum of 7 out of 7 Commissioners and the public present, ANC6E approved the following resolution by a vote of 7 in favor, 0 against, and 0 abstentions.

ANC6E is writing to express support for NOI 22-149-TOA, which proposes changes within the geographic boundaries of Single Member District 6E05. ANC6E is appreciative of the opportunity to provide feedback on this NOI and for the effort being devoted to improving traffic safety in Mount Vernon Triangle, where ANC6E has also devoted significant attention.

ANC6E supports the intent of the NOI to improve accessibility and to increase safety of the bike lanes on K Street. For these reasons, ANC6E is supportive of NOI 22-149-TOA as written. We further recommend that the ZICLA bus platform currently located at the outgoing K St NW and 6th St NW bus stop be relocated to the 504 K St NW bus stop, in front of the 7-Eleven.

Furthermore, there are a variety of related issues in the Mt. Vernon Triangle area: blocked bicycle lanes, unenforced PUDO zones, illegal parking/standing for passenger or goods delivery, unmet needs for staging of commercial delivery vehicles (NOI 22-91-TOA), and bus stop relocations. Creative and synergistic solutions may arise if these are all considered together. Therefore, ANC 6E requests a longer-term and holistic assessment of these related issues.
